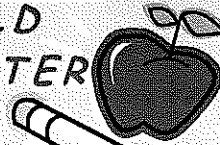

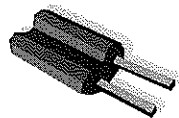

Parents As Partners

Grape Juice Popsicles

Find two clean, empty ice cube trays.

Fill each tray with grape juice. Leave about 1/8-inch from the top of each cube.

Cover the trays tightly with Saran wrap. The top of the wrap should be taut.

Insert toothpicks through the Saran wrap into each cube. Make sure the sticks are standing as straight as possible (some tilting is inevitable)

Freeze the ice cube trays for at least three hours

Remove the Saran wrap and gently pull the frozen grape juice cubes out of the tray. Place on a plate and serve.
