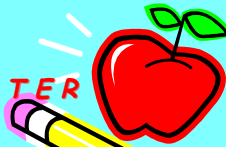

### Thanksgiving Art

Materials: blank paper, fall colored paint (red, yellow, orange, brown), marbles, box lid or clean pizza box, small cups or bowls, spoons

#### Directions:

1. Pour a little of each color of paint into a small cup or bowl
2. Drop one or two marbles into each color
3. Place a clean piece of paper into the box lid or pizza box
4. Using spoons, pick up the marbles and drop onto the paper
5. Tilt the box to allow the marble to roll back and forth on the paper (if using pizza box, close and shake.) tilt box in different directions to fully cover the paper with paint lines.
6. Allow to dry and use as placemats, or cut into pieced and use to make Thanksgiving note cards.
