Rice Krispie Treats

What you'll need:

- 3 tbl Butter or Margarine (do not use diet spread)
- 1 10 oz package regular size marshmallows
- 6 cups Rice Krispies Cereal

How to make it

1. In large saucepan melt butter over low heat, add marshmallows and stir until completely melted (mom or dad should do this)
2. Add Rice Krispies and stir until well coated- the mixture will cool to an easy to handle temperature then -
3. Using CLEAN hand (now this is fun part) press mixture into a 13x9x2 inch pan which has been coated with cooking spray or butter
4. Cut into squares and enjoy
